This could be the best Otis Kenyon Cabernet Sauvignon so far. A deep and clear cassis color creates high expectations and this wine does not disappoint. Bright red plum, eucalyptus and a hint of earth are the first aromas that meet your nose. As it opens up, cranberries appear, together with a faint whiff of real licorice bark. The flavors evoke sensuous fig, deep black cherry and bright strawberry, with undertones of fresh pouch tobacco and a touch of dust.

This wine is complex enough to entertain your senses all evening long on its own, but adding some spicy smoked ribs to the mix isn't going to be a bad decision either.
